


EDMS Redesign Opinion Survey summary results

Thank you to the almost **500 participants** who responded to the EDMS Redesign Opinion Survey! We are pleased with the response and thankful for your time and efforts to provide meaningful and helpful feedback. We collected **884 open-ended comments** and are reviewing them for potential current and future updates to the design and features.

Here are some highlights:


- **LDEQ employees** made up almost **70%** of respondents, with just about **340** participants.
- There were just over **150 Public/Other respondents**, including parish, state, and federal government employees, and environmental consultants.
- Overall, the survey responses were positive, with an average of **74.75% agreement or interest** on all rating questions about the new features being proposed.



EDMS Redesign Opinion Survey results on new features

In the survey, we focused on four different features:

- **Basic and Advanced Document Search**—Overall the responses were favorable on the proposed features, with an average of **73.2%** of the respondents indicating the new features **were beneficial to their searches** and they would **very likely use** them.
- **AI Lookup**—Over **80%** of the respondents agreed that the revamped features in the new AI Lookup would **enhance their searches**. Public users appeared to be more enthusiastic about the new features...with an average of **8% higher level of agreement** on the feature enhancements than LDEQ users.
- **MY EDMS Account and Saved Searches**—An average of **68%** of respondents indicated they would **likely use My EDMS to save searches and receive email alerts** with specific search parameters. Public users seemed **more enthusiastic about the features** than LDEQ users, with **81%** stating they would likely use these new features.
- **AI Map**—The ability to show a visual map with pin drops of AI result locations was very interesting to all respondents, with over **80% of Public users** likely to use this feature (see chart to the right). Over **68% of LDEQ users** indicated they were likely to use the AI mapping feature.
